Application Deadline Extended for Electric School Buses Funding Opportunity

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The Electric School Buses Funding Opportunity application deadline has been extended to **Jan. 18, 2021, by 5 p.m. EST.** The previous deadline was Dec. 18, 2020.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection has appropriated \$57 million from the Volkswagen Settlement for the purchase of **electric** Type C or Type D school buses, intended to replace eligible Type C or Type D **diesel** school buses.
