



# Call for Presentations

An Invitation to Present at the  
**2021 Annual FAPT Summer  
Pre-Conference Workshop**  
in Daytona Beach, Florida  
on June 20, 2021

Florida's school districts are making significant progress in the use of technology in areas such as vehicle and student tracking, FTE Count and Documentation, Video Monitoring, and Fleet Operations and Maintenance. It is the intent of the FAPT to offer case studies of the use of such technology at our 2021 summer conference to allow other districts the opportunity to see what works, what is being developed and tested and to obtain more information in district areas of interest.

## **Presentation Concept**

Supplier/vendors will be required to partner with one or more school district presenters to share their experience and offer real data to support their program or software. The presentation must be designed to help participants develop a better understanding of the program or practice and to become more knowledgeable about the subject matter.

## **Presentation Format**

The vendor/supplier will contact a partner school district to make a cooperative proposal (or vice versa). The presentation will be primarily led by school district staff, supplemented and augmented by the vendor(s). The presentation can include a panel discussion, power-point, video or other format. Several districts can present together on the topic. Formal presentations should be kept to 30 minutes or less with an additional 15 minutes for Question and Answer and sharing of ideas and information.

## **Submitting a Proposal**

Either a vendor/supplier or a school district/charter school may initiate and submit a written proposal. Each proposal must include

- Topic/initiative to be covered
- Name(s) of vendor/supplier and corporate product represented
- Name(s) of school district presenter and district
- 150-word summary of the subject matter to be discussed
- All contact information (both email and phone)

All proposals must include at least one school district and one vendor representative.

## **Acceptance and Cost**

All proposals must be received prior to April 1, 2021. Presentations will be scheduled on Sunday between 1pm and 5pm, June 20, 2021 at the Ocean Center. There are limited scheduled times available. Each proposal will be acknowledged and if accepted, presenters will be emailed on or before May 1, 2021. Due to the need to offset the cost the Ocean Center venue and the audio-visual services, there is a \$1000 sponsorship cost to the vendor of the product for the presentation. This sponsorship will be included with other sponsors in all promotional material, advertising and signage.
